Membership Categories

House 🌉


- (2) Access to the Clubhouse, Pool, Fitness Center, Member Dining, and Social Events
- Opportunity to play racquet sports (5) times per year (court fees applicable)
- Opportunity to play on the DuPont, Nemours, or Montchanin Courses (5) times per year during the "Limited Golf" available play times and may book a tee time (24) hours prior to desired date (greens fees applicable)
 - Usage of the outdoor driving range and short game area is included in each of those (5) times

Limited Golf /

Members choosing to participate in the "Limited Golf" category will upgrade their membership to include the following activities in addition to their "House" and "Racquets" membership privileges:

- (5) Access to play on the DuPont, Nemours, or Montchanin Courses any time on the weekdays
- (>) Tee times can be made up to (14) days in advance
 - During this time frame, (7) tee times will be allowed on the tee sheets. If (7) tee times are on the books, you will still be able to call the Golf Pro Shop to make a same-day tee time if there are openings.
- (>) Access to play on the DuPont or Nemours Courses after 3:00 PM on the weekends
- (5) Access to play on the Montchanin Course anytime on the weekends
- (>) Access to the outdoor driving range and short game area
- (5) Eligible to register for golf tournaments hosted on weekdays
- (5) Opportunity to reserve the indoor bays with Trackman technology at the Golf Practice Facility (4) days in advance (fees applicable)
 - (>) Hourly Bay Fee of \$30.00

- (>) Access to the racquets facilities, including tennis, pickleball, and platform tennis
- Opportunity to upgrade their membership by adding on the "Golf Practice Upgrade"
- Access to the "PourMyBeer" System at the Paddle Hut

Unlimited Golf 🙏



Members choosing to participate in the "Unlimited Golf" category will upgrade their membership to include the following activities in addition to their "House" and "Racquets" membership privileges:

- (5) Access to play on the DuPont, Nemours, or Montchanin Courses any time on the weekdays
- (21) Tee times can be made up to (21) days in advance
 - During this time frame, (10) tee times will be allowed on the tee sheets. If (10) tee times are on the books, you will still be able to call the Golf Pro Shop to make a same-day tee time if there are openings.
- (5) Access to the weekend lottery tee time system (Saturday and Sunday only)
- (5) Access to the outdoor driving range and short game area
- (5) Eligible to register for golf tournaments hosted on weekdays and weekends
- (5) Opportunity to reserve the indoor bays with Trackman technology at the Golf Practice Facility (7) days in advance (fees applicable)
 - Hourly Bay Fee of \$30.00



Membership Upgrades

Golf Practice



Available to the Racquets membership level (already built into the Limited and Unlimited Golf membership levels)

- Access to play on the Montchanin Course anytime during the week and after 3:00 PM on the weekends
- () Tee times can be made up to (72) hours in advance for the Montchanin Course
- (2) Access to the outdoor driving range and short game area
- (>) Billed **annually** per member, **not** pro-rated
- (5) \$800.00 per Racquets member

Indoor Contract



Available to the Racquets, Limited Golf, and Unlimited Golf membership levels

- (>) Places member in the priority lottery for Indoor Contract Time and the weekly court lottery during the Indoor Season
- Billed annually per member, not pro-rated
- (2) 2025 pricing to be determined

Membership Plans

Individual

Available to new joining members age (36) and up. Candidates will receive full privileges for the membership category they sign up for.

Young Adult

Available to new joining members between the ages of (22) and (35). Candidates will receive full privileges for the membership category they apply for. This category is available to both individual and family memberships.

<u>Family</u>

Consists of a primary member, the spouse or domestic partner of that member, and dependent children up to the age of (21). With any combination of two different adult memberships levels, all juniors will receive a complimentary junior membership at the lowest level of membership between those two.

With a single adult member, pay for the first junior and subsequent junior will be complimentary at the same level selected. Individual adult and junior fees are combined for monthly dues.

Minimum Spend Requirement

Annual Minimum Spend Category Individual Family Unlimited Golf, Limited Golf, Racquets (Including Young Adult) House \$350 \$700

Sports Plan

- Unlimited Golf, Limited Golf, and Racquets Members fall under the "Sport Plan" Category for Minimum Spend Purposes
- Individual Plan: Total annual spend is \$700 of which at least \$350 must be spent during each 6-month cycle
- (1) Adult Sports Member and (1) Junior Sports Member in Family Plan: Total annual spend is \$1,400 of which at least \$700 must be spent during each 6-month cycle
- Family Plan: Total annual spend is \$1,400 of which at least \$700 must be spent during each 6-month cycle
- (1) Adult Sports Member and (1) Adult House Member in Family Plan: Total annual spend is \$1,050 of which at least \$525 must be spent during each 6-month cycle

<u>House Plan</u>

- Individual Plan: Total annual spend is \$350 of which at least \$175 must be spent during each 6-month cycle
- (1) Adult House Member and (1) Junior House Member in Family Plan: Total annual spend is \$700 of which at least \$350 must be spent during each 6month cycle
- Family Plan: Total annual spend is \$700 of which at least \$350 must be spent during each 6-month cycle

Important Notes for All Membership Levels:

Exceeding Minimum Spend Amount During 6-Month Cycle: If a member exceeds their minimum amount required for Cycle 1 (\$350 for a Sports member or \$175 for a House member), then the excess amount spent rolls over into Cycle 2. Please note that excess spent at the end of the calendar year does <u>not</u> roll over into Cycle 1 at the start of a new minimum spending calendar year.

Failing to Meet Minimum Spend Amount During 6-Month Cycle: If a member fails to meet their minimum amount required during a cycle (\$350 for a Sports member or \$175 for a House member), that member is billed for the shortfall on their next billing statement. Please note that excess spent in the subsequent billing cycle will <u>not</u> be credited back to the previous cycle.

Spending by Families: Family accounts are blended and the combined spending amount of both adult members is calculated to satisfy the minimum spending requirement. Each adult member does not need to satisfy his/her requirement individually - combined total controls. Spending by junior members also applies to satisfying the family's overall minimum spend requirement.
